ASC Introduces the Season of Shelter! 2019-20 Season Starts in October

As a core program of Northwestern Settlement, Adventure Stage Chicago embraces the question "How can the arts contribute to the disruption of generational poverty?" to serve the critical mission of the larger social service organization.

Used as a guide with our 2017-18 programming dedicated to literacy and 2018-19 season of hunger, Adventure Stage will feature productions around the theme of "shelter."



Beginning in the Fall, we will debut *La Ofrenda (The Offering)* – a story about Alex who leaves behind his home that he loves after the loss of his parents in 9/11 to move in with his abuela.

Alex must learn to bridge the gap of grief through El Día de los Muertos.

In the spring, we will premiere *Ghost*, the story of a middle school student who finds his way onto an elite track team and finds something to run for instead of away from.
